General Information

The purpose of the following event is to promote a fun introduction to the competitive experience for the beginner skater. The competition is open to all skaters who are registered members in a U. S. Figure Skating Basic Skills Program and/or are current full members of the U. S. Figure Skating. Members of other organizations are eligible to compete but must be registered with the host Basic Skills program/club or any other Basic Skills program/club. Eligibility will be based on skill level as of closing date of entries. All SNOWFLOW SAM and BASIC SKILLS SKATERS THROUGH BASIC 8 must skate at the highest level passed and NO official U.S. Figure Skating tests may have been passed including MIF or individual dances.

This event is scheduled for Sunday, April 3, 2011. On-line entries with secure credit card payment may be made at www.kansascityfsc.com (follow competition links). Electronic entries must be paid with a successful credit card transaction to be considered valid and **must be completed by 11:59PM, February 20, 2011**. Paper entries must be postmarked on or before February 20, 2011 and must include all entry fees. Please make checks payable to "**Skate Kansas City**". A single check may be used to pay both entry and practice ice fees. The use of metered postage is not accepted as proof of postmark. Any paper application postmarked after February 20, 2011 or any electronic entry after 11:59PM, February 20, 2011 will be considered a late entry. Late entries will be accepted only at the discretion of the competition committee and a **late fee of \$25.00 will be charged. A \$25.00 service fee will be charged for checks returned for any reason.**

No refunds will be made after the entry deadline of February 20, 2011 unless an event is cancelled or closed due to large number of entries. Two entries will be sufficient to hold an event. Full refunds, **minus the on-line processing fee**, are available if withdrawal is prior to February 20, 2011. **If you register on-line, the processing fee is not refundable for any reason.** Refunds for paper entries withdrawn prior to February 20, 2011 will be assessed a \$25.00 handling fee.

Practice Ice

Practice ice will be available immediately prior to the competition on **Sunday, April 3, 2011**. No music will be played. Please mark the entry form if you wish to skate practice ice. Skaters will be divided into groups as necessary.

Music

All competitors must provide their music on compact disk (CD-R). CD-RWs will not be accepted due to compatibility issues. CDs must be clearly marked with the competitor's name, event, and running time. The official competition CD must be turned in at the Registration Desk at the time of registration. CDs must be turned in with a jewel case. Each CD must have only one piece of music. The official CD turned in at the time of registration is reserved for use during the event. No music will be played during Practice Ice. A duplicate CD should be readily available during the competition. Music should be picked up at the registration desk after your event is over. Kansas City FSC cannot accept responsibility for CDs.

Registration Check-in

Skaters may check-in on Saturday, April 2nd after 6:00 pm or Sunday, April 3 at least 1 hour prior to the first practice at the Independence Event Center. Please register upon arrival. Skaters should be at the rink at least 45 minutes prior to their scheduled event. Always check the registration desk for announcements of any possible changes.

Awards

Each division will be divided by age with no more than 6 competitors per group. All skaters will receive an award. Awards will be presented at the photographer's stand. All skaters in each group will be included in the award photo. All awards will be distributed and award pictures taken immediately following the posting of results for each event.

Photography/Video

No flash photography is permitted of the skaters on the ice. No tripods may be used and no rink power sources may be accessed. Only hand-held video cameras are permitted. Photos and video services will be available for purchase.

BASIC ELEMENTS EVENT: SNOWPLOW SAM – BASIC 8

Each skater will perform one element at a time in the order listed below (no excessive connecting steps).

- To be skated on 1/2 ice
- No music
- **All elements must be skated in the order listed**
- Time: 1:00 or less

<p><u>Snowplow Sam:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. March followed by a two foot glide and dip 2. Forward two foot swizzles 2-3 in a row 3. Backward wiggles 2-6 in a row 4. Forward snowplow stop 	<p><u>Basic 5:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Backward outside edge on a circle clockwise or counterclockwise 2. Backward crossovers 4-6 consecutive - both directions 3. Basic one foot spin – free leg held to side of spinning leg - minimum three revolutions 4. Side toe hop -either direction 5. Hockey stop
<p><u>Basic 1</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Forward two foot glide and dip 2. Forward two foot swizzles 6-8 in a row 3. Backward wiggles 6-8 in a row 4. Forward snowplow stop 	<p><u>Basic 6:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Standstill forward inside three-turn - R & L 2. Bunny Hop 3. Forward spiral on a straight line - R or L 4. Lunge - R or L 5. T-stop - R or L
<p><u>Basic 2</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Forward one foot glide - either foot 2. Forward alternating 1/2 swizzle pumps, in a straight line – 2-3 each foot 3. Two foot turn in place- forward to backward 4. Backward two foot swizzles 6 - 8 in a row 5. Moving snowplow stop 	<p><u>Basic 7:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Forward inside open Mohawk - R to L and L to R 2. Ballet Jump - either direction 3. Back crossovers to a back outside edge landing position clockwise and counter clockwise 4. Forward inside pivot
<p><u>Basic 3</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Forward stroking 2. Forward 1/2 swizzle pumps on a circle, either clockwise or counter clockwise 4-6 consecutive 3. Backward one foot glide - either foot 4. Forward slalom 5. Two foot spin – minimum three revolutions 	<p><u>Basic 8:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Moving forward outside or forward inside three-turns R & L 2. Waltz jump 3. Mazurka - either direction 4. 1 Combination move - clockwise <u>or</u> counter clockwise – two forward crossovers into FI Mohawk, step down, cross behind, step into one back crossover and step to a forward inside edge 5. Beginning one-foot upright spin – free foot held to side of spinning leg or crossed position -minimum three revolutions
<p><u>Basic 4</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Standstill forward outside three-turn - R & L 2. Forward outside edge on a circle clockwise or counter clockwise 3. Forward crossovers 4-6 consecutive both directions 4. Backward stroking - 4-6 strokes 5. Backward snowplow stop - R or L 	

BASIC PROGRAM EVENT: SNOWPLOW SAM – BASIC 8

The skating order of the required elements is optional. The elements are not restricted as to the number of times the element is executed or length of glides, number of revolutions, etc. unless otherwise specified. Vocal music is allowed.

- To be skated on full ice
- Time: 1:00 +/- 10 seconds
- The skater may use elements from a previous level
- A .2 deduction will be taken for each element performed from a higher level

Lunge - R or L 5. T-stop - R or L
<p><u>Basic 2</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Forward one foot glide - either foot 2. Two foot turn in place- forward to backward 3. Backward two foot swizzles 6 - 8 in a row 4. Forward alternating ½ swizzle pumps, in a straight line – 2-3 each foot 5. Moving snowplow stop 	<p><u>Basic 7:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Forward inside open Mohawk - R to L and L to R 2. Ballet Jump- either direction 3. Back crossovers to a back outside edge landing position clockwise and counter clockwise 4. Forward inside pivot
<p><u>Basic 3</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Forward stroking 2. Forward ½ swizzle pumps on a circle, either clockwise or counter clockwise 4-6 consecutive 3. Backward one foot glide – either foot 4. Forward slalom 5. Two foot spin – minimum three revolutions 	<p><u>Basic 8:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Moving forward outside or forward inside three-turns R & L 2. Waltz jump 3. Mazurka in either direction 4. 1 Combination move - clockwise or counter clockwise - two forward crossovers into FI Mohawk, step down, cross behind, step into one back crossover and step to a forward inside edge 5. Beginning one-foot upright spin - free foot held to side of spinning leg or crossed position -minimum three revolutions
<p><u>Basic 4</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Forward crossovers 4-6 consecutive both directions 2. Standstill forward outside three- turn - R & L 3. Backward stroking - 4-6 strokes 4. Backward snowplow stop - R or L 	

Artistic Program

Skaters must enter at the same level as their free skate event. If a free skate event is not being entered, skaters must enter at their current test level or one level higher. Vocal music is permitted. Skaters will be judged on musical interpretation and feeling, expression, and how the skating relates to the music. Show costumes are permitted, as long as they do not touch or drag on the ice. Only **hand held** props are allowed. Props must remain in the skater's hand(s) at all times. Deductions will be made for skaters including technical elements not permitted in the event description. Jumps and spins will be judged on their artistic merit in the program, not on technical difficulty. Events may be combined based on the number of entries.

Time: 1 Minute +/- 10 sec., to be skated on full ice.

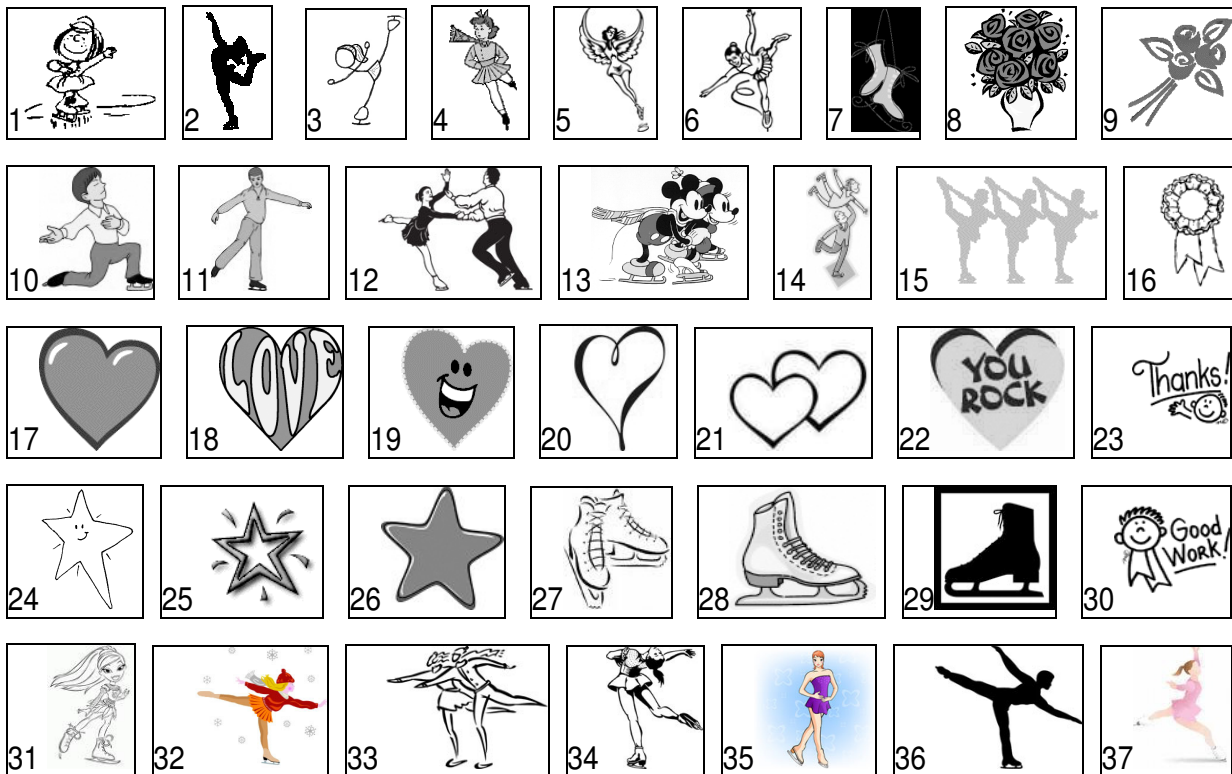
